Code § 6061 to include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• the date and polling hours of the election;</li><li>• the offices to be filled, specifying full term or short term, as the case may be.</li></ul> Cities are responsible for the publication of the "Notice of Election" for their measures and the publication of the "Notice to Submit Arguments"; the receiving and processing of primary arguments and rebuttal arguments; and the preparation of the Impartial Analysis. Due to cities consolidating with the county under Elections Code § 10400, the dates in the Yolo County Measure Calendar will be used for deadlines regarding arguments, rebuttals and the 10-calendar-day public viewing periods. Impartial Analysis is due from County Counsel for school and county measures or from City Attorney for city measures. The board of supervisors may direct the county auditor to review a county measure and prepare a fiscal impact statement, if applicable. Not to exceed 500 words.
